

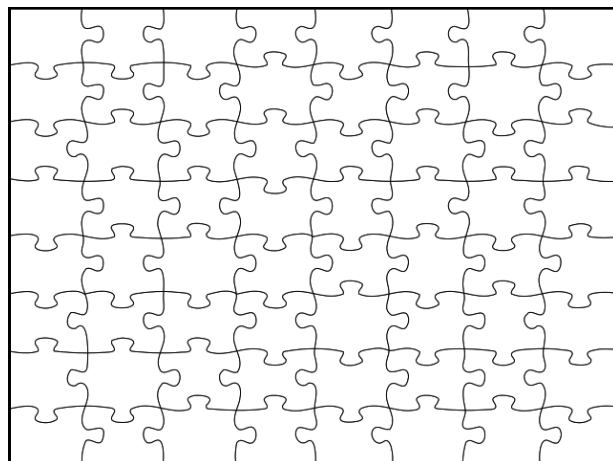
MAKE: FRIENDSHIP PUZZLE BRACELETS

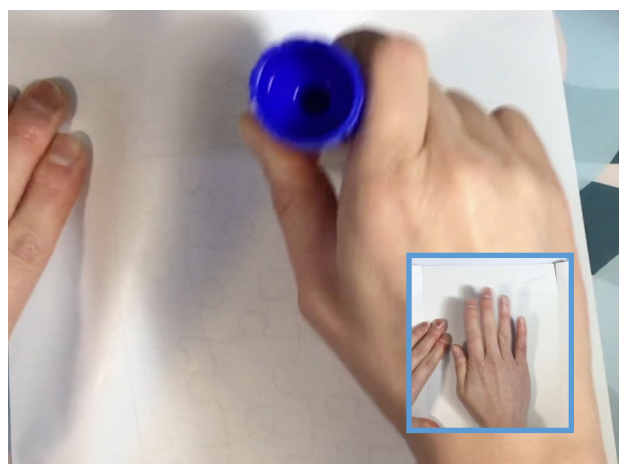
Celebrate friendship by making your own puzzle bracelets that fit together like pieces of a jigsaw! Each piece is unique but when joined together they make something beautiful. Send pieces of the puzzle to your friends so they can make their own bracelet that interlocks with yours.



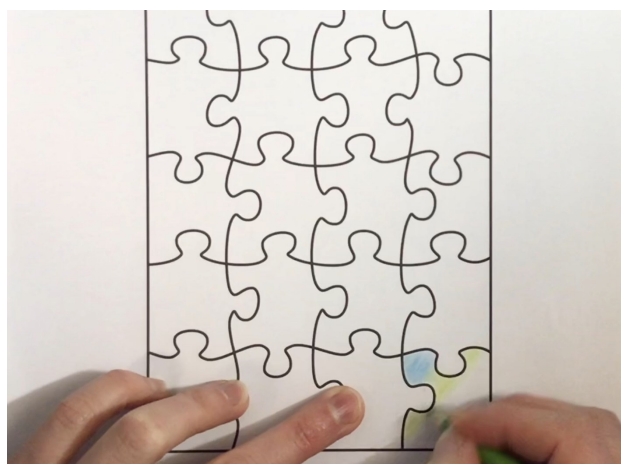
YOU WILL NEED: Glue, scissors, hole punch, sticky tape, paper, pens, pencils, glitter, buttons, beads, string, and thin cardboard.



STEP 1: Draw or print out puzzle template on a piece of white A4 paper.



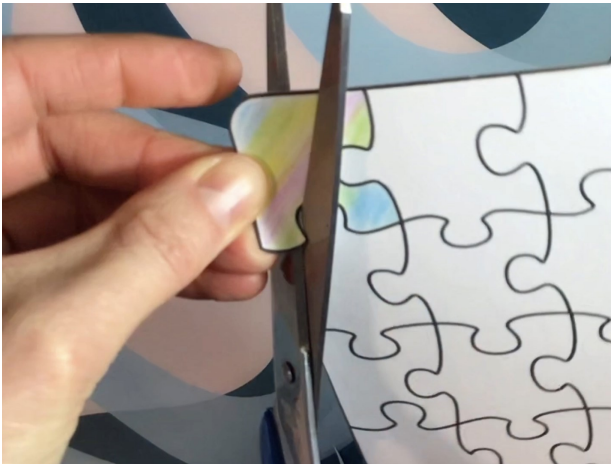
STEP 2: Glue the puzzle template onto thin cardboard.



STEP 3: Decorate one piece of the puzzle. Choose a piece that connects to as many other pieces as possible.

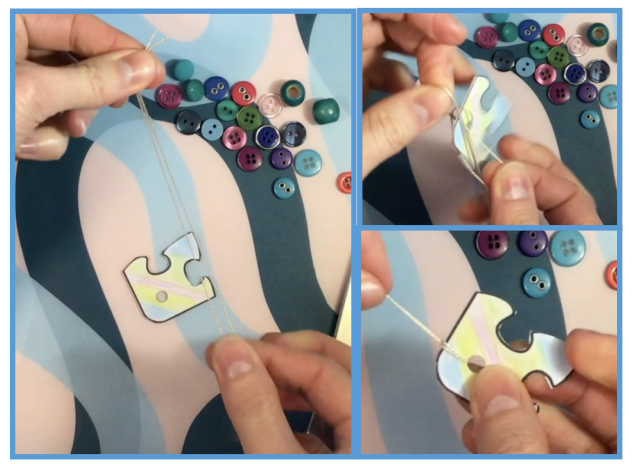
STEP 4: Cut out the puzzle pieces. Cut enough pieces for yourself and each of your friends.



STEP 5: Carefully punch a hold in one corner of your piece. Put a small piece of sticky tape on it before punching the hole to strengthen it.



STEP 6: Measure out a piece of string that fits around your wrist. Leave extra room for the beads and decoration.



STEP 7: Find the middle of the string and thread through the hole in your puzzle piece. Push both ends of the string through the loop and pull tight.



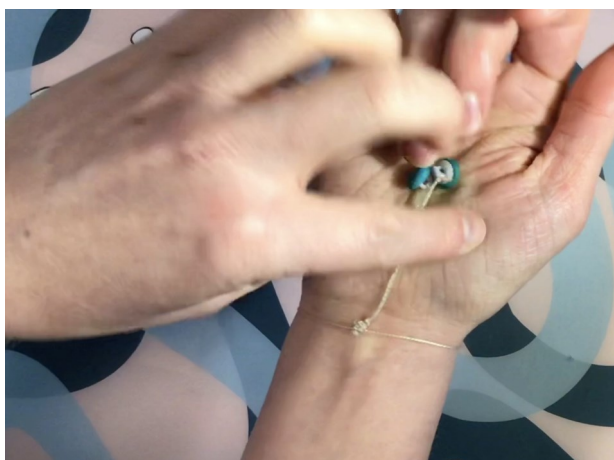
STEP 8: Thread beads or buttons onto each side of the string. Tie a knot to keep them in place. Tie a bead at each end of the string.



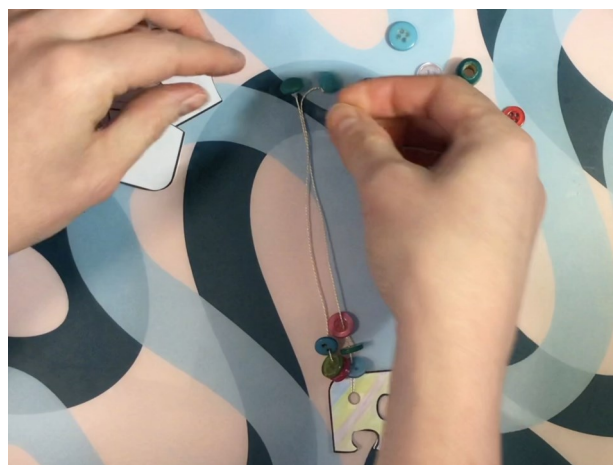
STEP 9: Send puzzle pieces to friends with a note to explain how they work.

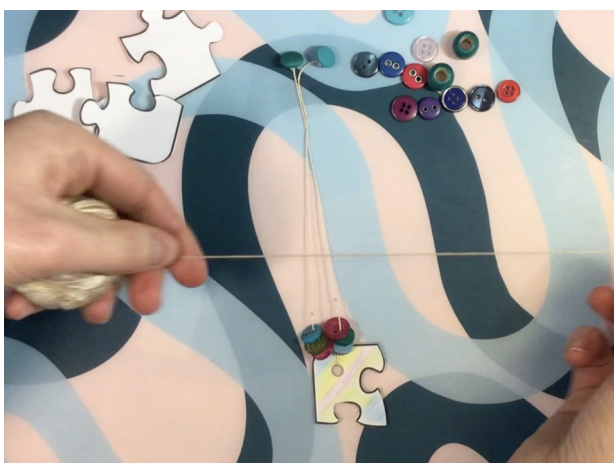

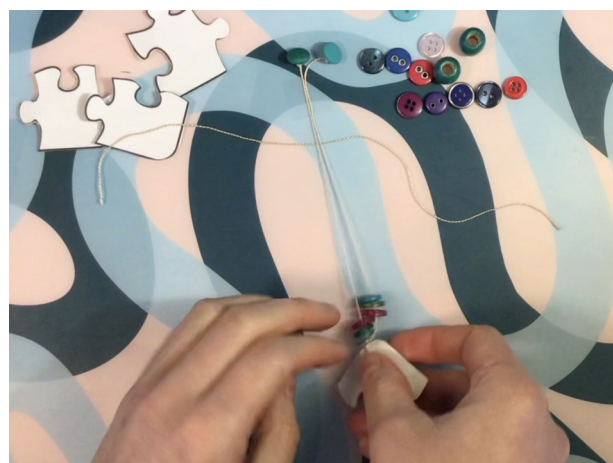
OPTIONAL: Create a decorative square-knottie that slides to adjust the bracelet's size to your wrist.



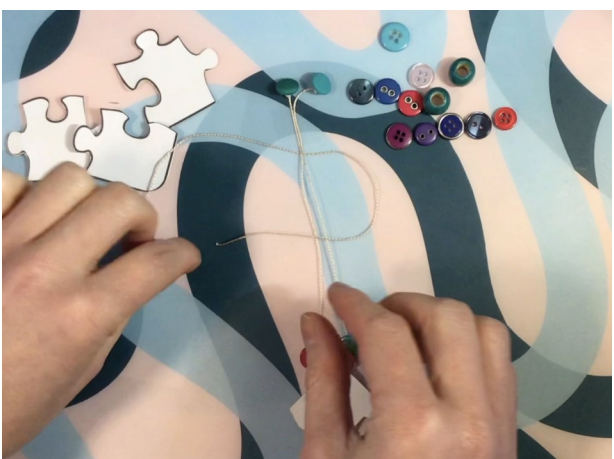
STEP 1: Tape the ends of your bracelet to the bench.



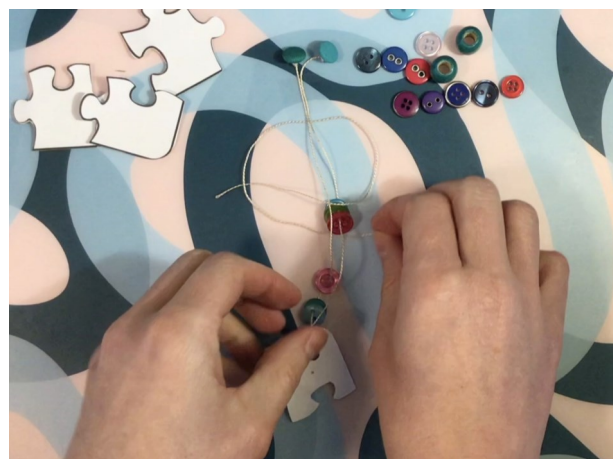
STEP 2: Measure out a piece of string that is about 10 cm long.



STEP 3: Place string evenly underneath bracelet.



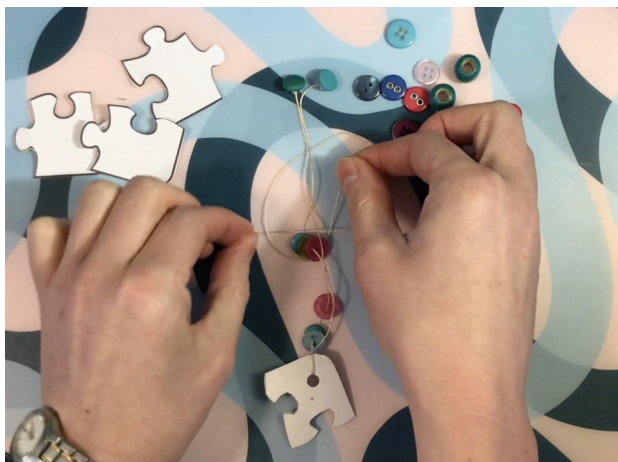
STEP 4: Take right end and place over top of bracelet.



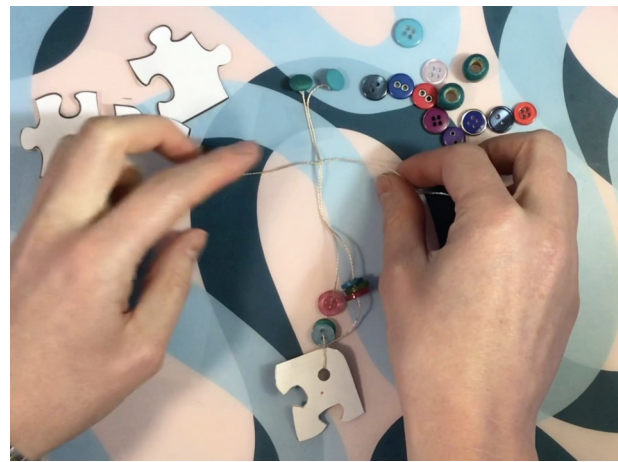
STEP 5: Take left end and place underneath bracelet.

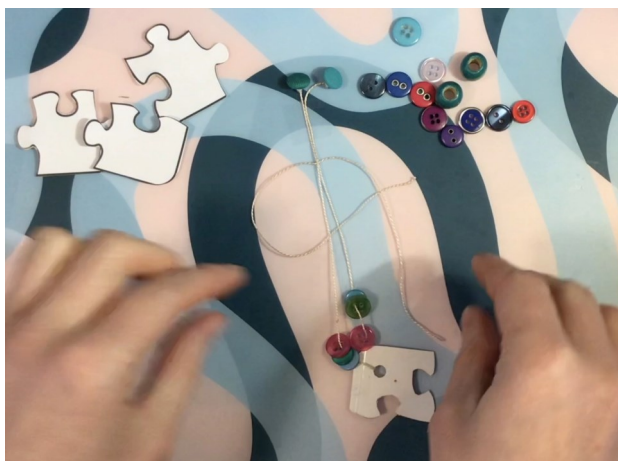

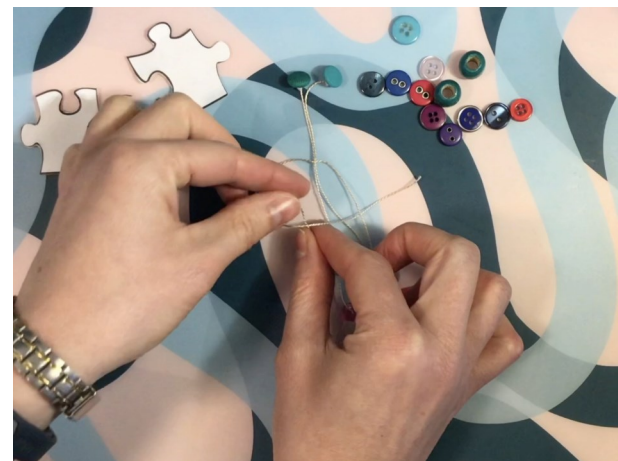
STEP 6: Take same end and pull up through the loop.



STEP 7: Pull tight.



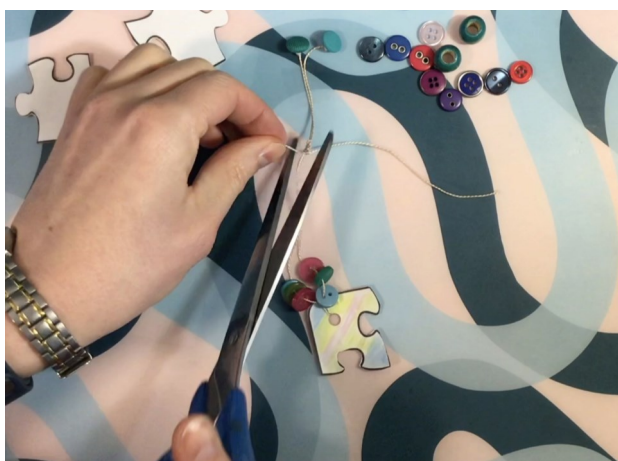
STEP 8: Take left end and place over bracelet.



STEP 9: Take right end under bracelet and up through the loop.



STEP 10: Pull tight. Repeat, alternating sides, until you have a knot that is at least four knots big.



STEP 11: Snip excess sting and if needed add glue to stop knot coming undone. The knot should slide along the bracelet.

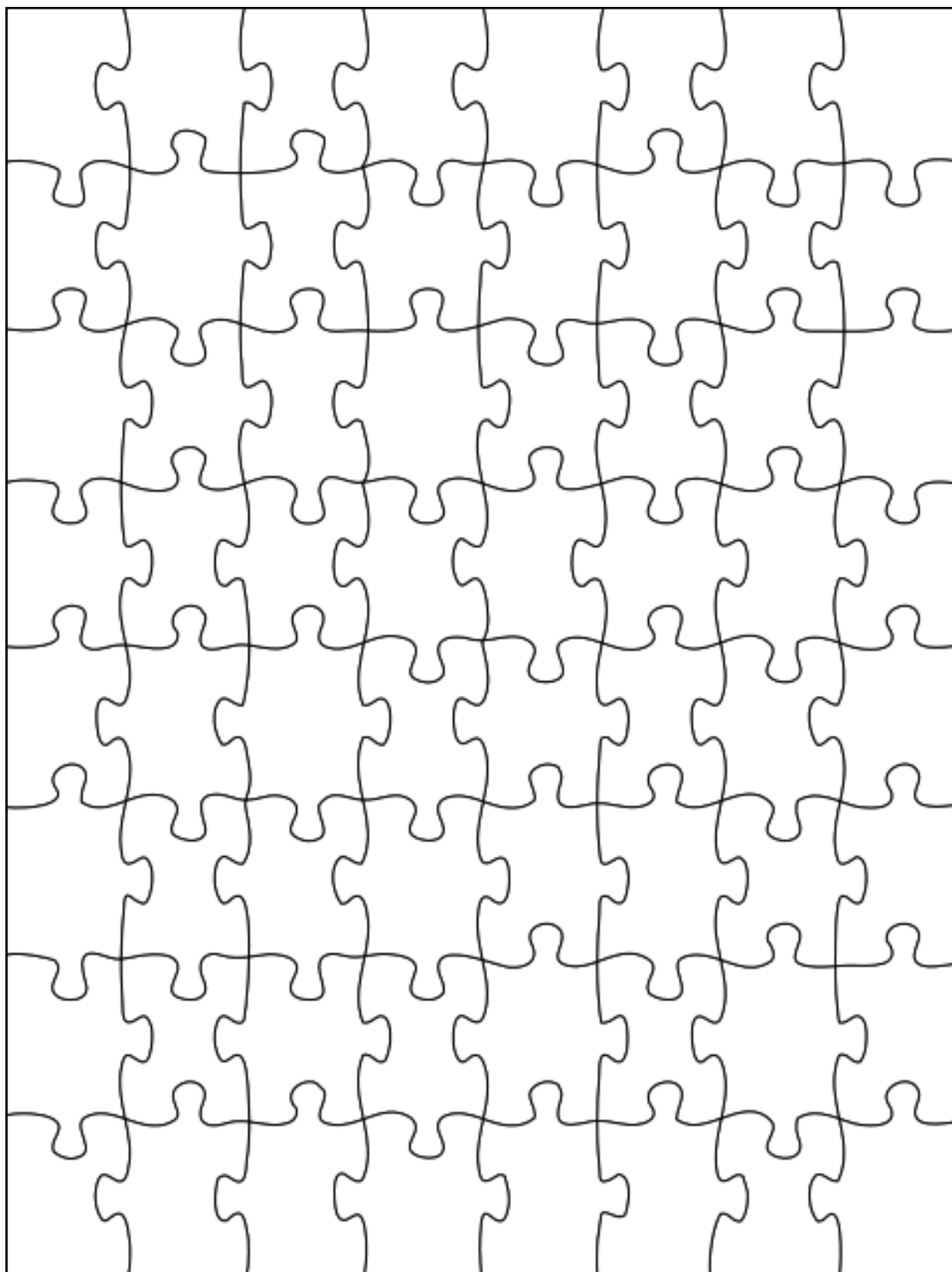
