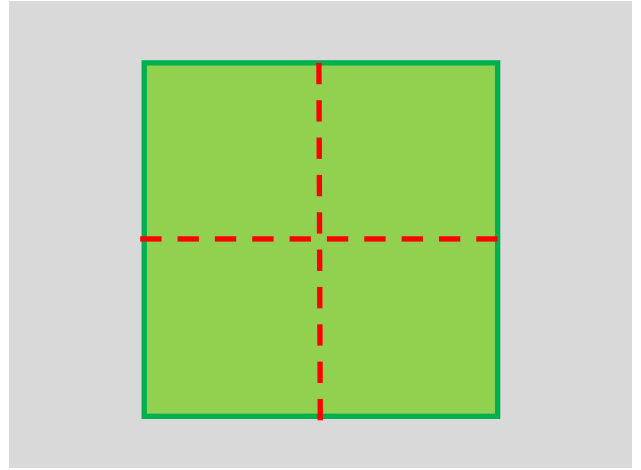

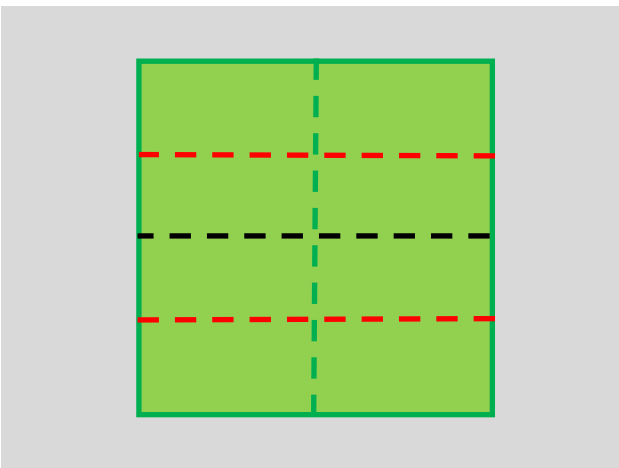
Enjoy the art of paper folding and create a crocodile inspired by Roald Dahl's story *The Enormous Crocodile*.



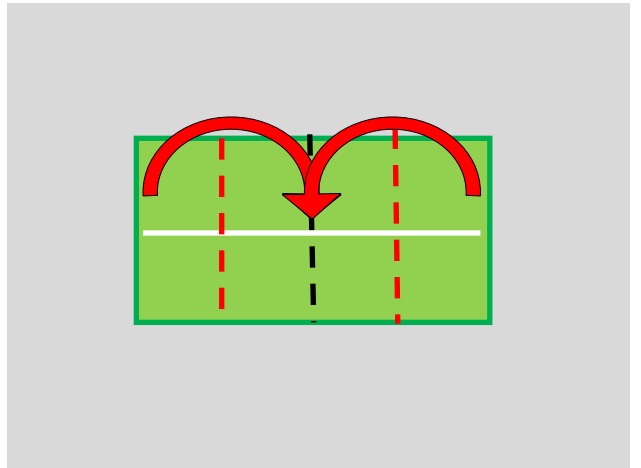
**YOU WILL NEED:** One square of green paper, black maker, or pen, and scissors.



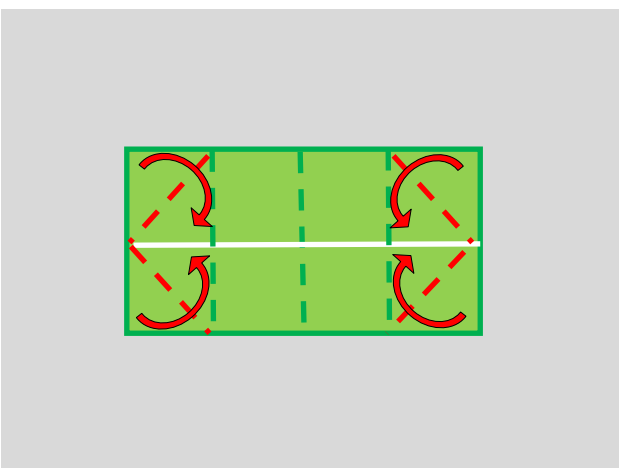
**STEP 1:** Fold paper in half and then in half again.



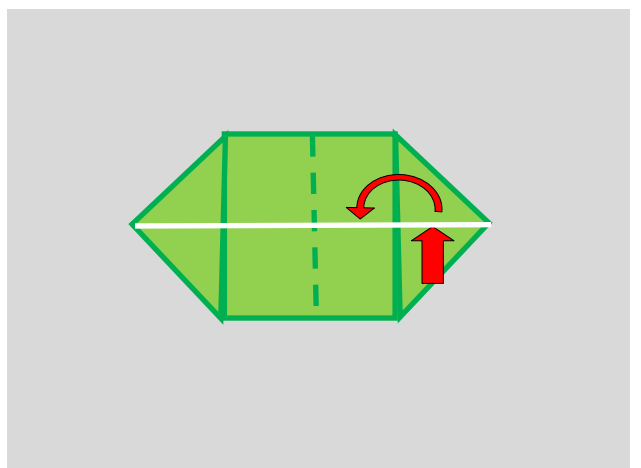
**STEP 2:** Fold the top edge to the black middle crease. Do the same with the bottom edge.



**STEP 3:** Fold the left edge into the black middle crease. Do the same with the right edge. Then unfold.



**STEP 4:** Fold each corner into the white middle line so they become triangle flaps.

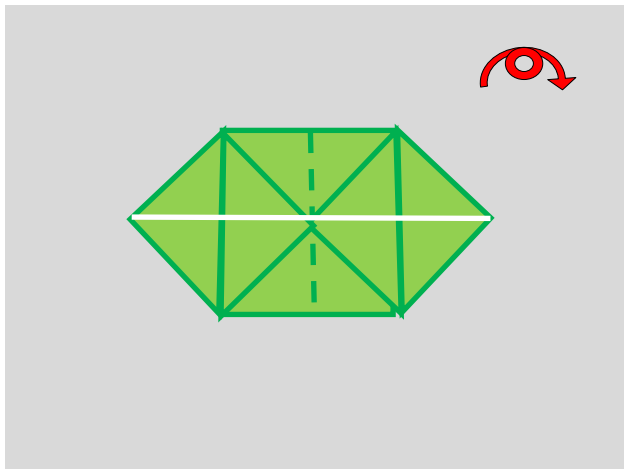


**STEP 5:** Open each corner flap and squash fold them to make larger triangles.

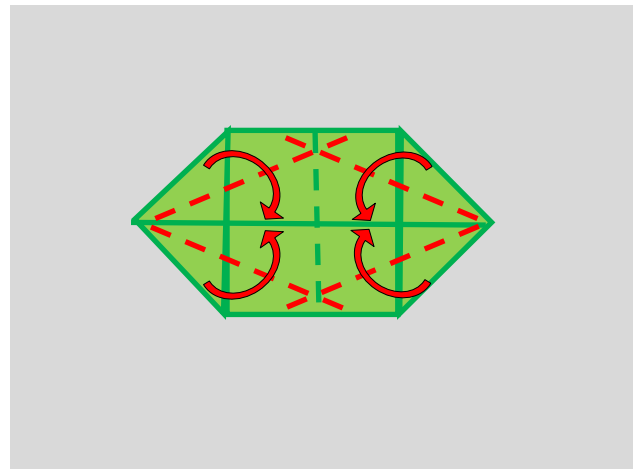

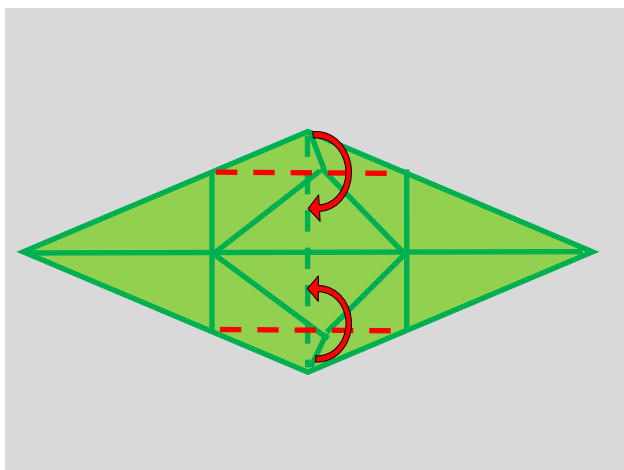

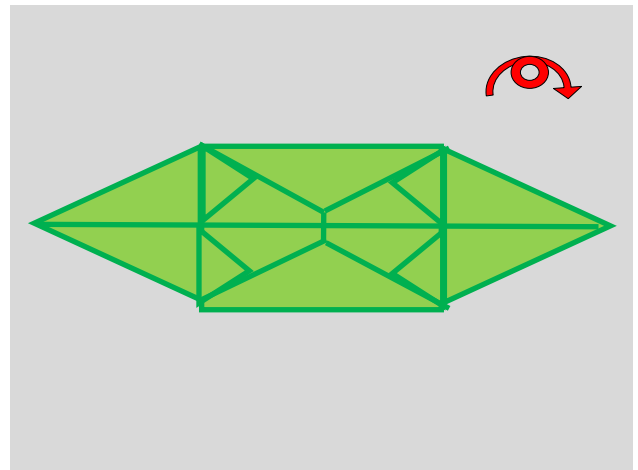
**STEP 6:** Flip over.



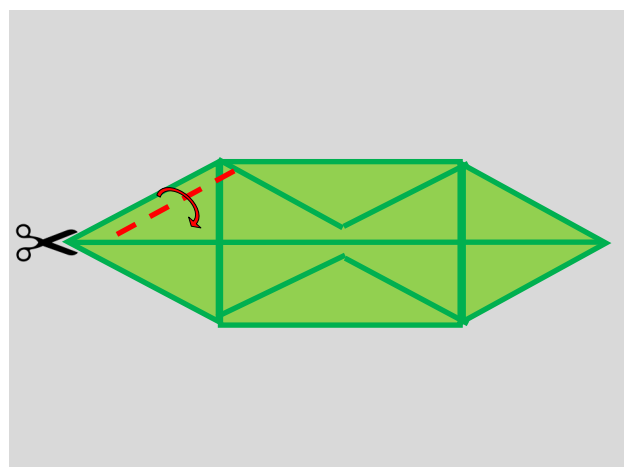
**STEP 7:** Fold the top corners to the middle line. Fold the bottom corners to the middle line.



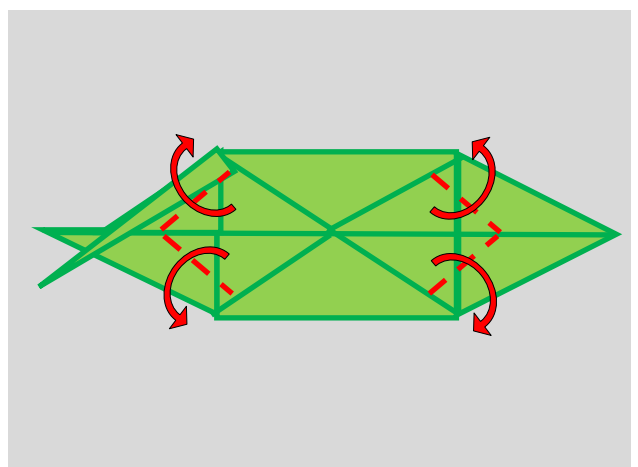
**STEP 8:** Fold the top and bottom corners in to the middle.



**STEP 9:** Flip over.



**STEP 10:** Cut from the edge along the middle line. Then fold the top flap down along the dotted line.

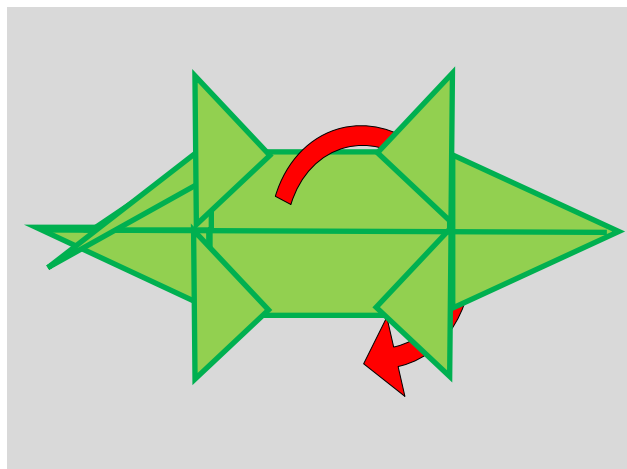


**STEP 11:** Fold the four triangle flaps of paper out along the dotted lines.

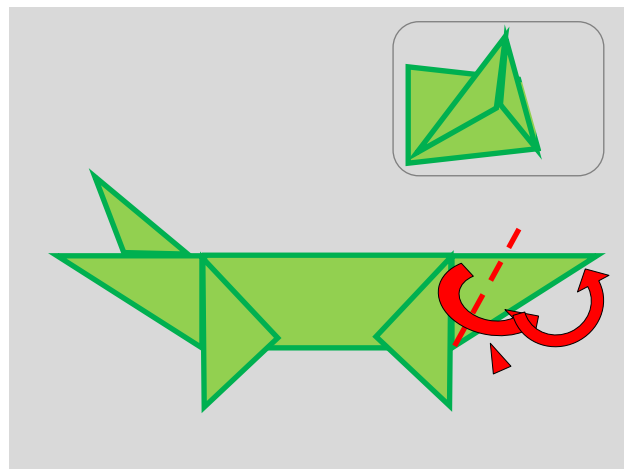

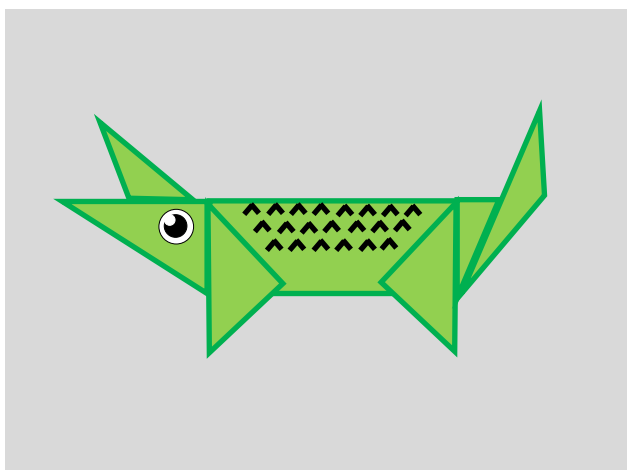

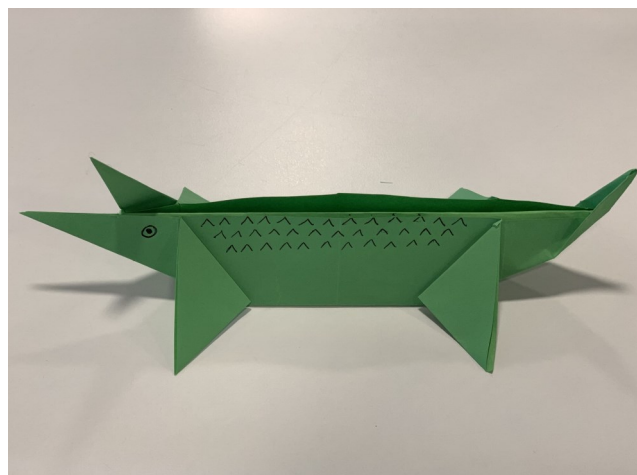
**STEP 12:** Mountain fold the paper in half bringing the top half behind the model.



**STEP 13:** Make an Outside Reverse Fold to form the tail.

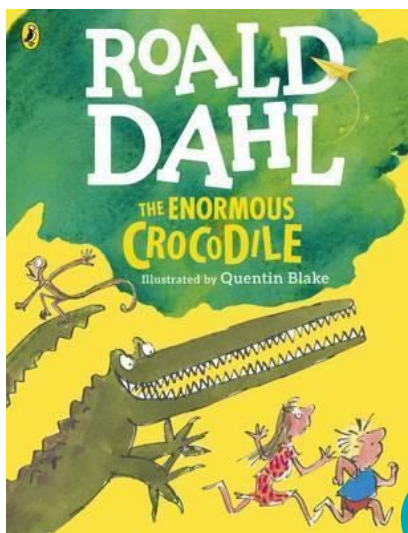


**STEP 14:** Draw on eye and spikes.
