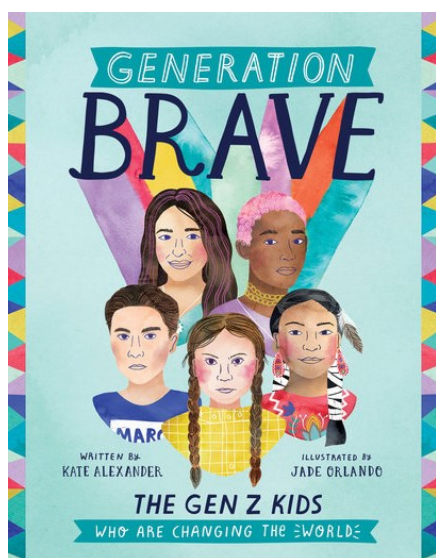


TITLE: Aussie STEM Stars: Munjed Al Muderis

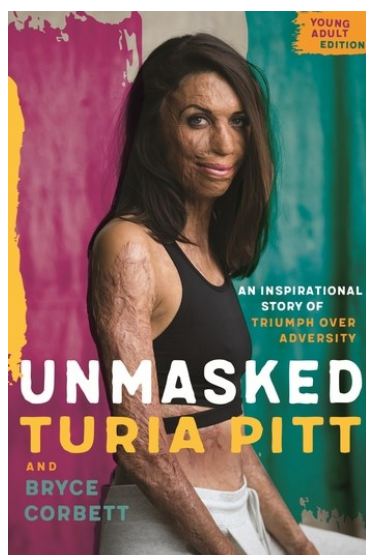


TITLE: Generation Brave: the Gen Z kids who are changing the world

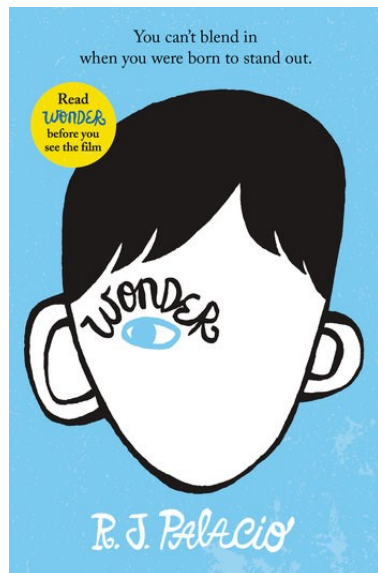
Telling the story of Turia's life before and after the fire, this young readers' this book unmasked the real Turia: funny, fierce, intelligent, flawed.

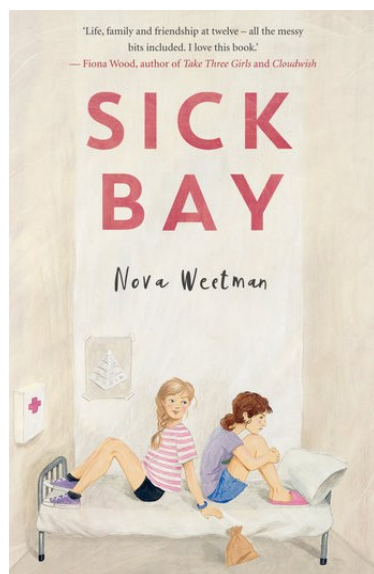


TITLE: Wonder

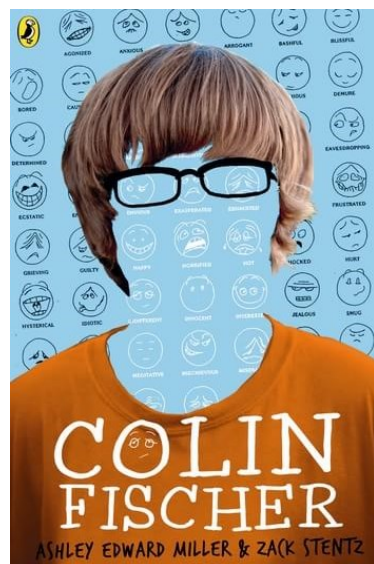
